



**Carpenter:** Job Type: Full Time Position:

The ideal candidate will be primarily responsible for building structures to the building structures to the blueprints and job specifications as well as numerous tasks assigned by the Project Superintendent. We will train.

Duties will include but are not limited to:

- Constructs, erects, installs, and repairs structures and fixtures of wood, plywood, and wall board, using carpenter's hand tools and power tools, conforming to local building codes.
- Marks cutting and assembly lines on materials, using pencil, chalk, and marking gauge.
- Shapes materials to prescribed measurements, using saws, chisels, and planes.
- Assembles cut and shaped materials and fastens them together with nails, screws, dowel pins, or glue.
- Verifies trueness of structure with plumb bob and carpenter's level
- Erects framework for structures and lays sub-flooring. Builds stairs and lays out and installs partitions and cabinet work. Applies shock absorbing, sound deadening, and decorative paneling to ceilings and walls.
- Follow specific directions, measure distances from reference points, establish and maintain level, plumb and straight lines and mark guidelines on working surface to layout work. Work within standards of accuracy.
- Fits and installs prefabricated window frames, doors, door frames, weather stripping, interior and exterior trim, and finish hardware, such as locks, closures, and kick plates.
- Constructs forms and chutes for pouring concrete.
- Perform other task(s) the company in its sole discretion, assigns to the Carpenter.
- Attendance is an essential function of the job. Depending on the needs of the job the employee could have other job/chores.

Physically, workers must be able to: Stand or walk for long periods; use arms and hands to reach for, handle and manipulate objects; lift and carry materials weighing up to 50 pounds; climb up and down ladders and other objects; lift and carry tools and equipment; stoop, kneel, crouch and crawl; see well (either naturally or with correction).
